

# NOMS SCIENCE SAFETY RULES



**Glue this side in your notebook**



- 1) Horseplay/running/shoving/etc. are serious hazards in the laboratory; such behavior is not permitted and will not be tolerated under any circumstances.
- 2) Food and drink are prohibited in the laboratory.
- 3) Remove any article of clothing such as a loose sweater or a scarf that hangs down and may touch a flame, chemical, or piece of equipment. Tie back long hair.
- 4) Safety goggles must be worn during activities that might be dangerous to the eyes. Wear an apron when directed to protect clothing.
- 5) All work surfaces should be cleaned after each use. Follow your teacher's instructions for throwing away or putting away supplies.
- 6) Do not lean back on your chair's rear legs. This is not only a danger to you but is a hazard to the lab groups near you.

- 7) Upon entering the laboratory, students are not permitted to touch laboratory until directed to do so.
- 8) Report any accident or breakage to your teacher immediately. Do not try to clean up broken glass by yourself.
- 9) Students should not taste, nor sniff any chemicals in the lab. Waft to detect an odor.
- 10) When necessary, hands should be washed thoroughly with soap at the conclusion of each laboratory period.
- 11) Students should note the location of all safety equipment.
- 12) Visiting other lab groups is not permitted unless directed to do so by the teacher.

13) Do only the experiments assigned or approved by your instructor and ask if you wish to experiment further.

14) Remember that the laboratory is a place for serious work. Follow procedures carefully and listen for any additions, corrections, or anticipated problems so you can record them in the lab.
